


Your Assignment: Design a Magazine Cover.

Step one: What magazine are you going to use? What is your cover going to be about? Brainstorm and come up with ideas of at least three different things you could do.

Step two: Pick one of your ideas and finalize what you will do. Draw up a Dummy of what you want to do. A Dummy is a rough draft, or a plan of what you want to do. You don't have to be an artist to do this.

Requirements:

1. The magazine cover design needs to be an actual PUBLISHED magazine that is appropriate for the classroom.
2. You must have at least one amazing photography that YOU have taken for this assignment on the cover of your magazine.
3. Your magazine cover can only have pictures that you have taken!!!
4. Write a minimum of three story teasers.
5. Make your cover look like a real magazine cover.
 - a. Issue Date
 - b. Barcode (can find online)
6. What can you do to make it better? Did you fill/use all the space? Is it a good design?
7. Your final work should look professional.



Step Three: Shoot your pictures for the cover.

Step Four: Make your cover.

Edit your photos for the cover. Levels, Color Balance, Curves, and Crop.

Go to File, New, and create an 8.5x11 inch canvas with Resolution at 300.

Go Edit Fill to change the background color. You can create boxes with the Marquee Tools and the Custom Shape Tool and fill them in with different colors...be sure to create them on a different layer so you can resize them and move them around as you wish.

Use the Move Tool to move your photos to the new canvas (use Two-Up) Use the Text Tool to create your text.

Use the Fx on the Layers Pallet to create drop shadows and Strokes on your text and photos.

Make it look like the real magazine!!!!
